What is re-examination of Calcutta University answer script or self-inspection?

In case of re- examination, student gets their answer scripts re-examined by the University whereas in case of self-inspection, University sends a photocopy of the answer script for students to evaluate and check their marks.

Who is eligible for re-examination and self-inspection?

A student appearing for any examination for the first time or repeating a particular year as a whole can give their paper(s) for re- examination, approximately within 15 days from the date of publication of result of the said subject (provisional or final) provided they fulfil the following provisions:

- 1) Student needs to have minimum of 35% of the total marks in the remaining Honours and general papers taken together (except for papers being given for recheck)
- 2) Student may seek re- examination of not more than 2 papers (Either 2 Honours or 2 General or 1 Honours and 1 General papers).
- 3) Student who has already opted for Re-Examination of 2 Honours paper on the basis of Pre-publication status of Marks cannot apply for Re-examination of General papers.
- 4) If result of a student remains "INC" (incomplete) due to non-availability of marks ONLY in Compulsory Language Group or Environmental Science or if a student remains absent from the Compulsory Language Group or Environmental Science, he/she may still apply for re- examination, subject to fulfilling the other conditions. In that case they have to provide their net copy of Marksheet.
- 5) Marks secured by student in Compulsory Language Group at Part I or in Environmental Science at Part III shall not be taken into consideration in order to determine the eligibility for re-examination. Also, there will not be any re-examination in Compulsory Language Group or Environmental Science.
- 6) Grace/deficit award shall not be taken into account in order to determine the eligibility for re-examination.
- 7) Student can apply for re-examination or Self inspection ONLY in theoretical papers.
- 8) Student can give maximum of 4 papers for self-inspection except Compulsory Language Group at Part I or in Environmental Science at Part III.
- 9) Student who failed to submit Re-examination application in Honours subject due to short percentage of marks may seek Re-examination in One Honours paper together with one General paper subject to fulfilment of other criteria as mentioned above.
