BRIEF INTRODUCTION TO THE SUBJECTS REQUIRED FOR THE SELECTION

01

Minor Electives

Students are required to choose 2 Minor Elective papers referred to as Minor1 (For Semester I & II) and Minor2 (For Semester III & IV), as selected by them at the time of admission.

B.Com. Students has to choose only their Minor Subject for Semester III to VI.

02

Inter-Disciplinary course (IDC)

Students will have to choose 3 IDCs (one each for the first 3 semesters). These subjects must not be the same as your Major and Minor subjects & also cannot be repeated in any other semester.

IDC subject is not applicable for B.Com. Students.

03

Ability Enhancement Course (AEC)

You must study one AEC subject each semester from I–IV, named Compulsory English as AEC 1 and AEC 2 in Semesters I & II (for B.Com./ B.A./ B.Sc), and choose from Hindi/ Bengali/ Alternative English in Semesters III & IV.

B.Com. Students will study Alternative English in Semester III & IV.

04

Common Value-Added Course (CVAC)

ENVS is mandatory as CVAC 1 and CVAC 3 in Semesters I & II, Constitutional Values as CVAC 2 in Semester I, while Semester II includes VOLS (CVAC 4) for B.A./ B.Com. and two CVAC options for B.Sc. students.



BRIEF INTRODUCTION TO THE SUBJECTS REQUIRED FOR THE SELECTION

Minor Electives

- **B.A.:** Choose Minor 1 and Minor 2 across Semesters I–VI. Minor 1 is studied in Semesters I, II & V, and Minor 2 in Semesters III, IV & VI. Example: If English is the Major, and Political Science and History are selected as Minors, choosing Political Science in Semester I makes it Minor 1 (Semesters I, II & V), while History becomes Minor 2 (Semesters III, IV & VI).
- **B.Sc.:** Choose Minor 1 for Semesters I & II and Minor 2 for Semesters III & IV. For Semesters V & VI, choose either Minor 1 or Minor 2 respectively. Example: If Physics is the Major, and Mathematics and Chemistry are selected as Minors, choosing Mathematics in Semester I makes it Minor 1 (Semesters I & II), while Chemistry becomes Minor 2 (Semesters III & IV). In Semesters V & VI, students may choose either Mathematics or Chemistry for each semester.
- **B.Com.:** Choose one Minor Subject for Semesters III–VI.

Inter-Disciplinary Course (IDC)

For Semesters I to III, you are required to choose 3 unique subjects as your Inter-Disciplinary course (IDC).

These IDC subjects must be different from your Major and Minor subjects.

For example: If your Major is English (Honours) and your Minors are Political Science and History, you cannot choose English, Political Science, or History as your IDC subjects in any of these Semesters.

IDC subject is not applicable for B.Com. Students.

Ability Enhancement Course (AEC)

All students need to study Compulsory English in both Semesters I & II.

For Semesters III & IV, B.A./ B.Sc students are required to choose between one subject from Alternative English/ Bengali/ Hindi as their second AEC subject.

B.Com. Students will study Alternative English in Semester III & IV.

Common Value- Added Course (CVAC)

Students are required to study 2 CVAC subjects in Semesters I & II.

For Example: In Semester I, ENVS and Constitutional Values are compulsory.

In Semester II, B.A./ B.Com. students will study ENVS and VALUE ORIENTED LIFE SKILL (VOLS), while B.Sc. students will study ENVS and choose either DOMESTIC APPLICATIONS OF ELECTRONICS (DAE) or HANDS ON MACHINE LEARNING (HML).



IMPORTANT NOTES

- Use a laptop or desktop for this process mentioned here. **The preferred browser is Google Chrome, ideally in Incognito mode. It is advisable to clear your browser history before doing the procedure.**
- Avoid using iPhones or iMac systems as you may experience issues with logging in or downloading/ viewing documents.
- Click the “Save” button after completing subject selection. This Subject Selection step is necessary to complete your Calcutta University Registration Process successfully.
- There is no need to submit any physical copy to the college premises.



PROCESS TO FOLLOW FOR SUBJECT SELECTION

Step 1: Login to BESC Student Console

c. Click on the “Send OTP” button to receive a One-Time Password (OTP).

- The OTP will be sent to your Institutional Email ID and the WhatsApp number that you had provided at the time of admission.

d. Enter the OTP received and click on “Verify OTP” to complete your login process successfully.



PROCESS TO FOLLOW FOR SUBJECT SELECTION

Step 2 - Semester-wise Subject Selection

a. Click on “**Subject Selection**” option available on the left side of the screen.

b. **Select your subjects (Minor / AEC / IDC / CVAC)** as shown in the above picture. Check carefully before saving. **NO changes will be allowed after submission.** Review and confirm the declarations along with the subjects & then click on “**Save**” to save all your selections.

- **B.Com. students** will only get the option to select **their Minor subject**, which will be studied from **Semester III to Semester VI**.
- It is **mandatory** for **B.A. and B.Sc. students** to select **all subjects**, i.e., **Minor, AEC, and IDC**.
Additionally, **only B.Sc. students** will get the option to select **CVAC subject**.

c. A confirmation email will be sent to your Institutional Email ID in after completion of the procedure. Please check your inbox/ spam folder for the same. **If you don't know your Institutional Email ID, [click here to know the same](#).**
