The most important derivation from the analysis:

- a. The gap between the student's choice of the better faculties in each department with the good faculties are wide based on the parameters. Perhaps a bench mark will help develop the key factors .
- b. For the faculties who need improvement, individual assistance and identification of root cause can enable a proper solution for improvement in the following areas
- 1. Completion of syllabus 2. Being punctual 3. Improve audio systems or use technology 4. Being accessible to students in a more regulated manner.

Here would suggest best practices of faculties who have been doing the above and have a higher rating can guide the others so that these can improve overall for the college.
