## FAQ ON RE-EXAMINATION & SELF-INSPECTION

1.	<p><b>What is Re-examination and Self-Inspection of the Evaluated Answer script of Calcutta University Examination?</b></p> <p><b>Re-examination, review or re-checking</b> generally refers to a process where a student can request the university to re-evaluate their answer scripts of their end-semester examination if they have concerns about the marking or grading. If any student is confident about their performance in the exam but not satisfied with the marks given, they can apply for re-checking for their paper.</p> <p><b>Self-inspection</b> refers to a process where students are given the opportunity to review their answer scripts or exam papers in person. In self-inspection, students will get a photocopy of their examination paper from the University of Calcutta, College Street Campus. This allows students to check their papers for any mistakes, verify the marking, or understand where they went wrong in their answers.</p> <p><b>The students who are very sure of their performance should always opt for Re-Examination as well as Self Inspection options.</b></p>
2.	<p><b>When can we expect the date of re-examination or self-inspection?</b></p> <p>Generally, the process of Re-examination and Self-Inspection starts within 15 days of the publication of the result. The process is conducted by the University of Calcutta.</p> <p>Students are advised to regularly visit the Notice section of the College website (<a href="http://www.thebges.edu.in">www.thebges.edu.in</a>) as all such notices as and when received from the University of Calcutta, are published on the College website.</p> <p>Students are also informed via SMS &amp; Email to their registered mobile number and Institutional Email ID.</p>
3.	<p><b>Who is eligible for re-examination and self-inspection?</b></p> <p>A student appearing for the concerned semester-end examination as a whole can give their paper(s) for re-examination &amp;/or Self-Inspection.</p> <p>A student appearing for their failed paper can give their paper(s) for Self-Inspection but cannot apply for Re-examination.</p> <p>Student needs to have a minimum of 30% of total marks in the remaining papers taken together (except for papers being given for recheck).</p> <p><b>Students can apply for re-examination/ self-inspection only in theoretical papers. There is no such provision for Internal/ practical / Tutorial papers.</b></p>
4.	<p><b>How to apply for re-examination and self-inspection?</b></p> <p>The re-Examination/ Self Inspection process is entirely online and is mainly divided into two parts.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) Application for Re-Examination / Self Inspection on the Calcutta University portal.</li><li>2) Making payment of the RC/SI application and filling up the requisite Google Form.</li></ol> <p>The detailed procedure for both the above processes shall be shared in the RC/SI notice published on the College website as and when the process starts.</p>
5.	<p><b>What are the charges for re-examination and self-inspection?</b></p> <p>Fees for Calcutta University Examination Re-examination &amp; self-inspection:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Recheck in one paper – Rs.110/-</li><li>• Recheck in two paper – Rs.210/-</li><li>• Self-inspection – Rs.500/- (per paper)</li></ul> <p><b>The student shall be allowed to apply for RE-EXAMINATION of NOT more than 2 papers &amp; there are no restrictions on the number of papers for the SELF-INSPECTION.</b></p>
