Biographical Sketch

I, Dr. Ivy Das Gupta am presently associated with The Bhawanipur Education Society College in the capacity of Assistant Professor of Economics. I have completed my M.Sc. degree from the University of Calcutta and M. Phil and Ph. D. degrees from Jadavpur University. My Ph.D. dissertation focused on the impacts of Intra-regional trade due to Free Trade Arrangements of the South Asian Association Regional Cooperation (SAARC) countries in 2005. It also examined the effects of abolition of Multi-Fibre Arrangement in January 2005 on the intra-regional trade among the SAARC countries, which governed the world trade in cotton textiles since 1974. I have also got the opportunities to work in multidisciplinary research projects where I had a good amount of experience of collaborative research at the ground level starting from literature review, questionnaire design, pilot survey, focus group discussion, primary survey, data collection, data interpretation, data analysis and final report preparation. I worked in Jadavpur University, Kolkata, India, as a Research Associate in the project 'MICRODIS - Integrated Health, Social and Economic Impacts of Extreme Events: Evidence, Methods and Tools' under sixth Framework Programme of European Union held by the Centre for Research on the Epidemiology of Disasters (CRED), University of Catholique de Louvain, Brussels in 2007-08 & 2010-11. Later I also worked in Jadavpur University as Co-Principal Investigator from March 2014 to 31st May 2015 in 'CAERUS - Evidence based Policy for Post Crisis Stabilization: Bridging the Gap', a project funded by 7th Framework Program of European Union in collaboration with University Catholique de Louvain, Brussels, Belgium.
