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# 1. Analysis of Students' Feedback



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#### **ANALYSIS OF 2023-2024 STUDENT FEEDBACK**


- 1. Student feedback indicates that more than 87% of students find the following to be satisfactory:
  - a. Teachers are regular and punctual in class (87% of respondents agreed).
  - b. The classroom facilities are good (according to 94% of students' opinions).
  - c. The overall quality of the college regarding the teaching-learning process, infrastructure, and student support services is good (89% of students agreed).
  - d. 91% of respondents agreed that the college environment is safe and secure for all.
- 2. Syllabus coverage as prescribed by the University of Calcutta, library facilities, technological support, and student-teacher relationships have been found to be quite adequate, according to over 83% of the respondents.
- 3. 88% of students felt that the overall learning environment in the college is good.
- 4. 82% of the respondents found that the laboratories are equipped with the latest apparatus and are properly maintained.
- 5. 87% of respondents agreed that technological support (use of teaching aids, models, slides, films, etc.) is optimal.
- 6. Almost 91% of respondents found that the sports and canteen infrastructure is good.
- 7. 89% of students stated that the number of value-added courses available would increase their chances of employability.
- 8. 93% of the respondents felt that the college gives importance to co-curricular and extracurricular activities. However, around 2% of students (respondents) indicated that the extracurricular activities were not adequate.
- 9. 85% of respondents found that the college's administrative offices are efficient and student-friendly.
- 10. 92% of students confirmed that the college washrooms are clean and well-maintained.
















































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# 3. Analysis of Teachers' Feedback



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## **Analysis of Teachers' Feedback 2023-24**

## SECTION 1: FEEDBACK RELATED TO TEACHING, LEARNING, EVALUATION & RESEARCH

- The analysis of teachers' feedback reveals that 76% of the faculty believe the college successfully attracts meritorious students for enrollment. Additionally, 98% of the teachers trust that student-centric resources are readily available, and classwork is conducted as per the schedule. Furthermore, 97% of respondents confirm that classes are held regularly.
- 92% of respondents feel that faculty members are consistently updating their knowledge base with relevant skills.
- According to the feedback, around 93% of teachers actively utilize college library resources. Nearly all respondents (99%) believe the library is efficiently managed, and 99% agree that the library timings are convenient. Additionally, 95% of respondents affirm that the procedure for acquiring new books and journals ensures the availability of required titles in the library.
- Approximately 94% of respondents believe that the teaching aids in the college are sufficient and up-to-date, indicating a high level of satisfaction with instructional resources.
- While 13% of respondents feel that faculty members should be further encouraged to engage in research activities, they identified challenges such as lack of time, limited international collaboration, insufficient funding, and the need for senior and expert researchers to join the research cell. However, 67% of faculty members assert that educators are encouraged to organize seminars, workshops, conferences, and similar events.
- Around 94% of faculty members believe the internal examination system, as per the college's guidelines, is effective.

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### SECTION 2: FEEDBACK RELATED TO INFRASTRUCTURE

• Approximately 96% of respondents agree that well-equipped classrooms are available in sufficient numbers. Additionally, 98% of respondents stated that the buildings are well-maintained. Water supply and safe drinking facilities were positively acknowledged by 93% and 97% of faculty members, respectively. However, 11% of respondents highlighted the need for an adequate number of toilets. Furthermore, 11% suggested improvements in laboratory equipment.

## **SECTION 3: FEEDBACK RELATED TO GOVERNANCE**

- Around 98% of respondents expressed satisfaction with the administration's efforts toward the institution's development. However, concerns regarding internet facilities, administrative accessibility, and freedom of expression were noted, which the college plans to address in the near future.
- Approximately 92% of teachers agree that the Memorandums of Understanding (MOUs) entered into by the college enhance opportunities for mutual cooperation with reputed institutions. The working strategy employed by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) to promote institutional quality is highly appreciated by 95% of faculty members.
- Around 72% of faculty members believe the college provides adequate opportunities and support to faculty and their families.
