APPLICATION FAQ (2025-26)

1. My Class XII Board is not listed in Recognised Board?

If the name of your class XII board is not there in the recognised list of boards, you are required to get an Equivalency Certificate from the University of Calcutta. Once they approve your board and give you the Equivalency Certificate, you need to email us the scan copy of your Class XII board marksheet along with the certificate issued by the University at admission@thebges.edu.in

2. I have applied in multiple courses; will I be eligible for merit list of all?

Yes, in case of multiple course/session applications, applicant is eligible for merit list of all the opted course/session, subject to fulfilment of merit list criteria & payment of Application fees for individual course/session.

Applicant can select any one of the Merit listed course/session & take admission, subject to fulfilling Calcutta University criteria as given on college website.

3. When will the Merit list be published?

The Merit List will be updated on the college website, under the Notice Board/Admission section. Please do not make any inquiry with college for the date of Merit list.

Application without the Payment of Application fees shall not be considered for the Merit List.

4. How will I be informed if I am merit listed?

Merit list shall be published on the College website under Notice Board/ Admission section. Merited student will also be informed via SMS & email. They can also check their merit list status by logging into their online profile using Applicant Login.

5. My class XII result is Compartment.

Students with Fail / Compartment result in class XII Board Examination are not eligible to apply for Undergraduate courses as per the norms of University of Calcutta.

6. My subject is not shown in the dropdown while entering the marks.

If the subject you studied in your Class XII board examination is not available in the drop-down menu while filling-up the marks, please email us the scan copy of your class XII board mark sheet at admission@thebges.edu.in

7. I do not have my last name / Surname.

If you do not have Last name / surname or if the same is not mentioned in your class XII Board Admit card / Marksheet, you can use a blank space (by pressing space bar just once) to fill-up in the Last name field in our Application form.

8. My School's name is not in the list

If the name of your school is not available in the list of institutes, you are required to select the other institute option from the drop down which will enable Sr. no. b(ii) and then type your school's name in the other institute box.

9. Is there any charge for Application?

Application charge is Rs. 750/- (Seven Hundred Fifty rupees only) per Application.

For Example, If you have applied for B.Com. Morning Session & B.Com. Evening session, or BBA & B.A. English your application charges to be paid is Rs. 1,500/- (One thousand five hundred rupees only).

So for every application you do, you have to pay Rs.750/- in order to make it a Valid Application.

Application without the Payment of Application fees shall not be considered for the Merit List.

10. The subject in which I want admission is not shown in course selection list while applying.

If you are not getting the course in which you want to take admission while filling up the application form, please read the eligibility criteria as you might be ineligible for that course. Please also ensure that you have entered all subject marks in your application.

11. I have done a mistake in typing my name in the application form, will it impact my merit listing probability.

The Merit list is dependent on the followings:

- a) Your class XII board marks.
- b) Your category (General/SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B)
- c) Class XII Board
- d) Gender

Until and unless you have done a mistake in the above three, your chances for the Merit list will not be impacted.

You are requested to rectify the mistakes done in your application by login into the "Applicants login" and if you are unable to rectify them, please send us an email at admission@thebges.edu.in from your registered email id regarding the corrections you are not able to do yourself. Do mention your application number and the corrections required.

12. Can I change my marks entered in the Academic Details as I have done a mistake while entering?

Yes, you can rectify your marks entered till you get Merit listed for any course. Academic details get locked once you get Merit listed.

13. I have selected wrong School name.

If you have selected a wrong school name, please immediately report the same to Admission helpdesk via query form. Particularly if you have selected "The Bhawanipur Gujarati Education Society School (ISC)" and you are not from the same school as it may impact the merit list eligibility.

14. How to Add course to my existing Application?

Step 1: Visit College website www.thebges.edu.in. Click on "Admissions 2025-26". Click on "Applicant Login" to access your online profile by using your Login ID (your registered Mobile No.) & Password or Login by using OTP option.

Step 3: Select the Course or Session you want to apply for from "Course Selection" list.
